CONFERENCE ORGANISATION

Presentations & Abstracts

No theme has been set for the conference, and any papers relevant to Mining History will be welcome. Individual oral presenters other than keynote speakers will be allocated 20 minutes with an

additional 5 minutes for questions. Strict timing will be adhered to. Presentations should be saved on disk or memory stick and handed to one of the organizers well before the scheduled session.

There will also be the opportunity for poster presentations and time during tea breaks for presenters to talk to their posters. Posters should be designed to fit an area of ca. 0.9x1.2m. Poster boards will be provided.

GETTING TO BURRA

There is no convenient public transport to Burra. It is a two-hour drive from Adelaide. If you do not wish to drive yourself, there will be mini-buses travelling from Adelaide Airport on Sunday 26 September. You must arrive at the airport before 4.00 pm.

ACCOMMODATION – BOOK EARLY

A wide variety of accommodation is available in Burra. There are several hotels, 2 motels, numerous B & Bs or self-catering cottages and a caravan park.

CLIMATE AND DRESS

Average September maximum temperature in Burra is 17°C, and average minimum 6°C. On average, there are 12 rain days in September. Bring clothes suitable for cool days and nights and possibly showers. Dress code for the conference is casual, ranging to smart casual for the Council reception and conference dinner. Field trips call for sturdy, closed footwear. Carry water on tours.

VENUE

The main conference activities will be held at the **Burra Town Hall**, Market Street, Burra. The front entrance is reached by steep stairs. There is a ground level entrance on the north side, which can be reached on foot by a ramp from Market Street, or by car via Mount Pleasant Road.

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

In order to run an environmentally responsible conference we aim to minimise waste by using conference bags of recyclable material and we ask you to provide your own pens and notebooks. If you have a 'keep cup' for coffee/tea please bring it. Plastic bottles of water will not be provided on excursions so please bring your own refillable water bottle.
